**Bachelor of Nursing/Bachelor of Business Administration
Additional Course and/or Unit Information**

As with all national nursing curricula in Australia, the ACU Bachelor of Nursing/Bachelor of Business Administration (BN/BBA) has recently undergone the required five-year accreditation review. In 2018 ACU will be offering a revised BN programme which will be taught-in progressively over three years (2018 year one of the new BN; 2019 years one and two of the new BN; 2020 years one, two and three of the new BN).

For those students currently studying at ACU (having enrolled in the BN or BN double degree programme in 2017 or earlier), you will be expected to follow the course map which was provided with your original course enrolment. The existing BN will be taught-out as the new BN is taught-in (2018 years two and three of the existing BN, 2019 year three of the existing BN, 2020 no existing BN units on offer). If your original study plan requires you to complete a unit which is no longer offered by ACU (and this will not occur until 2019), you will be required to seek course advice from a Course Coordinator who will assist you to revise your study plan using the unit equivalency table. This table identifies units in the new programme which are equivalent to those in the existing programme.

Compulsory for all undergraduate courses

All undergraduate students are required to complete the University Core Curriculum as part of their course. The Core Curriculum is comprised of three units and further information on its structure can be found on the [Core Curriculum](#) webpage. The Core Curriculum units specific to your course are indicated on the course map and can also be found in the Handbook.

The Australian Catholic University Core Curriculum has been designed to focus on aspects of the University's identity and mission. These units emphasise critical judgment, clear expression, ethical decision-making and concern for others, as individuals and as a community.

The two University Core Curriculum units in the Bachelor of Nursing/Bachelor of Business Administration are:

UNCC100 Self and Community: Exploring the Anatomy of Modern Society

UNCC300 Justice and Change in a Global World

These units are often taught over differing week patterns to allow for student placements at various times during semester. Students should take special care to note the week pattern of tutorials when they allocate in tutorial direct to ensure that they are choosing the correct stream for their course.
