2020 Unit Selection

You must enrol for both semesters, not just Semester 1.

Not only is this a requirement of the Academic Regulations, but ACU also uses enrolment information to understand the demand for each unit and schedule enough spaces. Enrol now for the full year so you don't miss out on the units you want. You can easily change your Semester 2 units later if you change your mind. Remember, Semester 2 tuition fees are not due until August.

Additional Unit Information

If a unit is offered in more than one delivery mode (e.g. online mode and multi-mode), **domestic** students can enrol into whichever delivery mode suits them best. **International** students, however, must enrol into at least one multi-mode or attendance mode offering per semester and can study an overall maximum of one third (1/3) of credit points in online mode. Please seek a course advice meeting with your Course Coordinator if you are unsure about your unit enrolment for 2020.

The option to study this course part-time is only available to domestic students.
